

Give A Miracle a Chance: Playing the GAME of life.

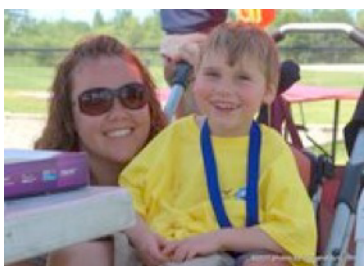


This is the story of a bright and beautiful boy named Denton. He is now seven years old and his engaging smile is encouraging to everyone who knows him. Diagnosed with Quadriplegic Cerebral Palsy (CP) at birth, doctors determined Denton's brain was 85% damaged and he wouldn't live longer than 48 hours. He was a fighter though, and through prayers, faith, hope and a miracle Denton survived and continues to open new paths in his life.

A community campaign known as Give A Miracle A Chance (G.A.M.E.) was created for Denton, successfully raising funds to a much needed hyperbaric oxygen and conductive education therapy. The prosperous campaign provided treatment for Denton with positive results and continuing gains. After seeing how the groundbreaking campaign affected Denton's life, G.A.M.E. spread its reach out to all Special Needs children to offer hope, assistance and support towards building a brighter future. G.A.M.E. has branched out and continues heightening the awareness and hope for other families to be encouraged.

In 2008, G.A.M.E. became recognized as a registered charity. The volunteer-based group continued pursuing its goal of supporting children living with Special Needs and championing them towards independent therapies and treatments. G.A.M.E. is growing and has recently created the Bridge the GAP. We have clearly seen the results of the intervention we support through the success of our children: first steps, new milestones, happy faces.

G.A.M.E. fills the gap for children and families living with Special Needs, so they can have a more positive outlook on life and afford the health intervention attention these children need.
